

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAFE USE

The correct use and maintenance of your cot/bed will ensure it gives long and trouble-free use. Please ensure everyone use your cot/bed know how to use it. The safety of your child is your responsibility.

- WARNING: Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas
 fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the cot.
- WARNING: Do not use the cot/bed if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only spare parts approved by Babymore.
- WARNING: Do not leave anything in the cot or place the cot close to another product which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/curtain cords, etc.
- WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.
- WARNING: When converted to a child's bed, do not place this bed near heat sources, windows and other furniture.
- The lowest base position is the safest. Once your child is old enough to sit up unaided the base should be used in the lowest position only.
- If your leave the child unattended in the cot, always make sure that the movable side is closed
- The thickness of the mattress chosen shall be such that the internal height (surface of the mattress to the upper edge of the cot frame) is at least 500mm in the lowest position of the bed base and at least 200mm in the highest position of the bed base.
- The line engraved on the cot end indicates the maximum thickness of a mattress that can be used with this cot when the bed base is in the top position.
- We recommend the use of a mattress minimum size of **70cm by 140cm** for this cot. With a thickness not exceeding 10cm. The length and width of mattress shall be such that the gap between the mattress and the sides and ends does not exceed 30mm.
- Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap of 300mm between the wall and the side of the bed.
- Please ensure that all assembly fittings always be tightened properly before use. And fittings should be checked regularly and tightened as necessary.
- The cot is only ready for use, when the locking mechanism(s) are engaged, check the mechanism(s) is fully engaged before use.
- Your cot/bed may be cleaned with a damp cloth. Never use bleach or harsh abrasives.
- To prevent injury from falls, once the child is able to climb out of the cot, the cot should no longer be used for that child.
- This cot bed is intended for children aged from birth to 4 years approximately.
- The cot conforms to EN 716-1/2:2008 + A1:2013. When converted to bed, it conforms to BS 8509:2008 + A1:2011.

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

BEFORE ASSEMBLY

- ☐ Unpack all the parts and identify them against the components and fitting lists.
- $oxed{\boxtimes}$ Do not discard any packaging until you are sure you have all the parts and fittings.
- ☐ If you find any part missing or damaged or incorrect, contact customer services of above.
- Read the instructions thoroughly before attempt construct the cot/bed.
- You may find the construction easier with help of another person, in the room for use, on a soft clean floor so there is no damage caused to the furniture during construction.
- ☐ Follow each stage of construction step-by-step.






F / Bolts 20mm x 8

Step 1

Align and install base slats onto base support bars.
Use bolts F to secure slat onto the support bar, as diagram show.





A / Bolts 55mm x 8




B / Barrel Nuts x 8


Step 2

Choose 1 of 3 bases position as show, main diagram show base panel install onto the end panels, with above fitting.

Leave bolts
connection loosen

A / Bolts 55mm x4


Step 3

Install fixed side to ends by pass (A) bolts through predrilled hole onto cot ends.

Leave bolts

connection loosen

until step 6





C / Bottom Pin x 2




D/Top Pin x 2

Step 4

Refer to the magnified diagram, attach top pin (D) and insert Botton pin (C) onto both cot ends.

Do not over tight.


Ensure correct way

(Outside/Inside) of

dropside panel for

assembly. "Push" label

Align and insert top pin into top recess of dropside panel, push cot end panels outward to allow extra space where required.





Step 6

Rotate the bottom of drop side panel, carefully align the lower recess with bottom pins on cot ends, use your finger push down the top of bottom pin, allow it be inserted into the long groove of plastic tracks.

TEST THE DROP SIDE OPERATE AS NEXT STEP

<u>Fully tighten all the</u> <u>connecting bolts.</u> Maximum mattress height mark:





Step 7

To lower the dropside, Lift up the dropside from centre, hold while using your leg to push at centre of bottom bar inward, then allow panel to slide down to lower position.

To raise the dropside, Lift up the dropside from centre, hold while using your leg to push at centre of bottom bar inward, then pull up until it clicks into the locking position.

Always verify that both ends of the dropside are locked in the up position whenever a child is in the cot.



CONVERT TO DAY BED / BED




E / Allen Key

Step 1

Remove the dropside, insert (C) Allen key through the holes of the dropside, push down top of bottom pins, to remove the dropside.

Disassemble the cot by reverse the assembly step 6 to Step 1.






A / Bolts 55mm x 8




B / Barrel Nuts x 8

Use the above fitting attach base panel (3) onto the cot end tops.

Ensure base label side upward.

Fully tighten bolts

It does not cover any used, second hand or demo models.

This warranty does not cover any damaged or defective parts that result from installation and assembly, normal wear and tear, abuse, negligence, improper use, incidental damages or alteration to the finish, design, and part or fitting of the cot. This in no way affects your statutory rights
