INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAFE USE

The correct use and maintenance of your changer will ensure it gives long and trouble-free use.

Please ensure everyone use your changer know how to use it. The safety of your child is your responsibility.

- WARNING: DO NOT LEAVE THE CHILD UNATTENDED. The safety of your child is your responsibility
- Check regularly that all the fittings and screws are correctly tightened and are not damaged. Loose screws can pinch parts of the body and clothing resul ting in the risk of strangulation.
- Do not use replacement parts that are not recommended or supplied by Babymore
- Do not place your productin the near vicinity of open fires or other sources of strong heat, such as electric or gas fires.
- Always leave your product clean and dry. Wipe away any spillage straight away. Your product can be cleaned with a damp cloth. Never use harsh abrasives, bleach or strong detergents
- Before use, ensure the dresser is on a stable, level surface.
- Do not allow children to climb on the changer.
- Never use the changer if any parts are broken or missing.
- Never pivot or drag the changer on its feet, must always be lifted by at leasttwo people when moved.
- A changing mat is not supplied with this product. We recommend that you only use size 75 x 45cm changing mat with maximum thickness no more than 1 inch (25.4mm). Place the changing mat on the changing surface, evenly within the retaining rails.
- This product is intended for child from birth to 12 months, up to 11kg.

WARNING: WALL STRAP INFORMATION

- The wall strap is only intended to be used with the Babymore productthatitis supplied with.
- Never attempt to modify or change the wall a ttachment strap in any way. Never use any other fittings for attaching the strap to your furniture than those supplied.
- Never use the screw provided to attach the strap to the wall. No wall attachment fittings are supplied. This is because the type of fittings required to attach the strap to the chosen wall is determined by the composition ofthe wall. If you are in any doubt about the correcttype of fittings to use, consult a professional before attempting to attach the strap to the wall.
- The wall strap must not be used to replace any other fitting supplied with your piece offurniture.
- Furniture falling over is generally due to the surface the furniture is placed on. A warped floor or wall-to-wall
 carpeting will enable the furniture to rock, so greatly increasing the potential for the furniture to fall. Ifthe
 furniture is placed on a flat level wood or tiled floor the risk is reduced, but we still recommend the wall
 strap is fitted.



BEFORE ASSEMBLY


- Unpack all the parts and identify them against the components and fittings lists
