

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAFE USE

The correct use and maintenance of your changer will ensure it gives long and trouble-free use.

Please ensure everyone use your wardrobe know how to use it. The safety of your child is your responsibility.

- WARNING: DO NOT LEAVE THE CHILD UNATTENDED. The safety of your child is your responsibility
- Check regularly that all the fittings and screws are correctly tightened and are not damaged. Loose screws can pinch part of the body and clothing resulting in the risk of strangulation.
- Do not use replacement parts that are not recommended or supplied by Babymore
- Do not place your productin the near vicinity of open fires or other sources of strong heat, such as electric or gas fires.
- Always leave your product clean and dry. Wipe away any spillage straight away. Your product can be cleaned with a damp cloth. Never use harsh abrasives, bleach or strong detergents
- Before use, ensure the wardrobe is on a stable, level surface.
- Do not allow children to climb on the wardobe.
- Never use the wardrobe if any parts are broken or missing.
- Never pivot or drag the wardrobe on its feet, must always be lifted by at least two people when moved.

## **WARNING:** WALL STRAP INFORMATION

- The wall strap is only intended to be used with the Babymore productthatitis supplied with.
- Never attempt to modify or change the wall a ttachment strap in any way. Never use any other fittings for attaching the strap to your furniture than those supplied.
- Never use the screw provided to attach the strap to the wall. No wall attachment fittings are supplied. This is because the type of fittings required to attach the strap to the chosen wall is determined by the composition ofthe wall. If you are in any doubt about the correcttype of fittings to use, consult a professional before attempting to attach the strap to the wall.
- The wall strap must not be used to replace any other fitting supplied with your piece offurniture.
- Furniture falling over is generally due to the surface the furniture is placed on. A warped floor or wall-to-wall carpeting will enable the furniture to rock, so greatly increasing the potential for the furniture to fall. If the furniture is placed on a flat level wood or tiled floor the risk is reduced, but we still recommend the wall strap is fitted.


#### **BEFORE ASSEMBLY**

- Unpack all the parts and identify them against the components and fittings lists
- Do not discard any packaging until you sure you have all the parts and the pack of fittings.
- If you do find that any parts are missing or damaged or incorrect, contact customer services.

- You may find the construction easier with help of another person, in the room for use, on a soft and clean floor so there is no damage cause to the furniture during construction.


#### Adjusting the doors







Adjusting the height of the doors. Loosen screws 'C' then slide the hingeplates up or down until the doors are even then tighten the screws.





Adjusting the angle of the door. Loosen screw 'A' and slide the hinge arm either forwards or backwards until the door is vertical then tighten screw 'A'.

Any spare components should only be thrown away after you have fully constructed your product. After disassembly, it is important to retain all metal fixings and components for reassembly in future.

Please keep your receipt so that we may process your warranty request. This warranty only covers new units with original packaging and ownership, and is nottransferable. It does not cover any used, second hand or demo models.

This warranty does not cover any damaged or defective parts that result from installation and assembly, normal wear and tear, abuse, negligence, improper use, incidental damages or alteration to the finish, design, and part or fitting of the item. This in no way affects your statutory rights.
